 The goal of the Dislocated Worker Program is to help you find suitable employment at comparable wages with minimal disruption to your life.

Dislocated Worker Eligibility

- Terminated through no fault of your own or laid off
- Received a notice of termination or layoff
- Displaced homemaker
- Self-employed but unemployed as a result of general economic conditions
- Dependent spouse of a member of the Armed Forces on active duty

Required

- Valid identification that includes date of birth
- Social Security card
- Layoff letter if applicable
- For Veterans: DD214
- Selective Service Registration if applicable
